From these Scriptures, what do we see was expected regarding the newly "inaugurated" Church...and why?

In light of this, what should we understand to be fundamental to the life the Church of today?

What is the difference between a prophetic process and a prophetic manifestation?

Discuss what we often don't have enough of when it comes to fulfilling our potential?

Discuss the meaning of the word “Hebrew” and why this is significant for the Church today?
