"First this: God created the Heavens and Earth—all you see, all you don't see. Earth was a soup of nothingness, a bottomless emptiness, an inky blackness. God's Spirit brooded like a bird above the watery abyss."

Genesis 1:1-2 MSG

This is the season of divine flutterings!

When Genesis tells us "the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters" (Gen. 1:2 KJV), this has the connotation of a mother hen sitting on her eggs waiting for them to hatch.

The word *moved* in this verse of Scripture is translated as "flutterings" in ancient Hebrew.

The flutterings of the Spirit are prophetic promptings God will place on the inside of you to do something.

Just as God's Spirit hovered over the "soup of nothingness" in Genesis, so will His Spirit hover over you with prophetic flutterings indicating there is something He is forming in you for His purposes.

God is trying to get your attention and point you towards an assignment that is connected to the unfolding of His plan for humanity.

You may not understand how His promptings are connected to what He is doing throughout the world, but paying attention to those "prophetic flutterings" has a great deal to do with how God anoints you.

I pray you will learn how to move with God's Spirit in this season.

Whenever there is a prophetic fluttering, that divine unction will eventually become a burden—and if you are willing to heed those promptings, they will become a driving passion that defines your purpose and legacy.

What will the anointing help you to overcome?

Read John 3:34

According to this verse, what are you prepared to ask God for?
