In his letter to the Corinthians, Paul wrote, "My message and my preaching were not with wise and persuasive words, but with a demonstration of the Spirit's power" (1 Corinthians 2:4).

Discuss what we learn from this lesson about what humanity has lost their appetite for —and why.

Describe what the message of the Kingdom enables believers to do and/or become.

Share how you will begin walking in that reality as of this very moment.
