- What does Paul tell Timothy to do and why?

- What do we learn from this lesson about what God wants us to become?
- Discuss what Rejection teaches us.
 - What can we learn from Loss?
 - Describe how Problems and Crises instruct us?
- Pause to reflect on what problem God may be calling you to solve.
- Where will the enemy always fight you?
- What are the lessons we learn from History?
- How do your Pain Points offer instruction?
 - What might they show you or point you toward?
 - Reflect on the pain points in your family, community, or workplace.
- Discuss the instructors with whom you are currently in class.

Read Ecclesiastes 1:16 and Genesis 30:27

- What do we learn here about our first instructor in the school called life?
- Consider ways in which you have leveraged Experience?
 - How is God going to use your experience?
- What is the value of a testimony?
- Explain what your experiences point you toward—and for what purpose.
 - What aspect of God are your current experiences pointing you toward?
- Pray to discern what you should be learning today from Experience.
