“THE CONFRONTATION”

LESSON ONE DISCUSSION GUIDE

Discuss the different perspectives of the four gospels and what we can learn from each.

Read Mark 4:1-2

What do we learn about the process of discipleship from the example of Jesus?

Discuss the first thing we learn about Christianity—or becoming a Christian—from this example.

What does the enemy conspire to do and how?

Discuss the most effective way to control a group of people.

Read Philippians 2:5

What is the mentality of Jesus?

Discuss the mind—or mentality—we should have?

What is the world system structured to do?

How are we as believers positioned within that system?

Read Matthew 13:3,10-13

Discuss the context Jesus was attempting to provide here?

Briefly describe His four main objectives for coming to the earth.

How are these relevant to the way we should navigate the world's system?

Read Luke 19:10

As you understand it from this lesson, what did Jesus come to help people do?

Therefore, in your opinion, what is the message of the Kingdom?

Discuss what we learn from this lesson about the concept of sin.

What are we being saved from?

Read Revelations 18:1-13

What are we to “come out from” referenced in verse 4 of this passage?

Discuss the significance of what read at the end of verse 13.

What does the system of the world want to control?

Describe the alternatives offered by the teachings of Christ.

Read Ecclesiastes 10:5-7

Discuss this passage in light of what we have learned.

What, therefore, does the message of the Kingdom enable us to do?
