“THE LIFESTYLE”

"As for the seed that fell upon good, rich soil, it represents the hearts of people who hear and fully embrace the message of heaven's kingdom realm. Their lives bear good fruit."

Matthew 13:23 TPT

We know from the Parable of the Sower that the Sower is Christ, and that the Seed is His Word sown in our hearts.

From this we can be sure that there is nothing wrong with the Sower, nor the Seed.

If your life is not producing an abundant harvest of good Kingdom fruit, we can conclude, therefore, it must be due to the condition of the soil.

The soil is the condition of a person's heart.

Simply put, the soil is your character.

The nature of your character determines the receptivity and capacity you must have in order to receive the message of the Kingdom.

Describe how the different types of “soil” manifest in a Christian’s life.

Discuss what we learn here about the importance of character.

Read Galatians 5:18-25

Discuss what Christian character looks like.

What is the difference between Heaven and the Kingdom?

Describe the type of Christian who lives within the Kingdom, versus those who live outside the Kingdom.

How can you tell the nature of a person's character?
Take a few moments to discuss the power of choice.

Read Matthew 6:33

What must we choose to do as believers and why?

Talk about some of the challenges that often keep you from living more fully in the Kingdom.

Discuss steps you will take this week to apply what you've learned tonight.
