#### **Read Deuteronomy 30:19-20**

Describe what heaven does when you choose life.

Discuss the significance of serving the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

- What is God about to do for you?

- What is God about to shift?
- What is God about to change?

What is the worst kind of deception?

Discuss the three primary things we learn from the story of the Prodigal Son.

### **Read Deuteronomy 8:16-17**

Describe what the world is filled with—and what is available to you.

What does God give you the power to do?

- What is wealth?
  - Where must one first have wealth?

Take a few moments to acknowledge the many forms of abundance.
